- Dark green shoulder loops on epaulets. [EXCEPTION - office emblem may require alternate color]

- Official BSA uniform pants or shorts. Neat, clean and intact.

5pts **Right Sleeve**

- US Flag
- Patrol Emblem. *[National Honor Patrol Stars, if earned]*
- Quality Unit Award (only the most recently earned Quality Unit Award may be worn)*

5pts **Left Sleeve**

- Rainbow Council emblem
- Troop Numerals *[With 50 year Veteran Unit Award]*
- Current Badge of Office*
- BSA Trained Leader Emblem [Office must be present]*
- Den Chief Award braid over left shoulder*

5pts **Right Pocket**

- Jamboree Insignia [only one]*
- Interpreter strip, if earned, must be centered above the BSA strip above the left pocket flap.*
- Order of the Arrow lodge insignia s worn on the right pocket flap. Must be official BSA.*
- Temporary patches/insignia, if worn, must be centered on the pocket or hung from the button.*
- Recruiter strip is worn centered below the right pocket.*

5pts **Left Pocket**

- Current oval-shaped badge of rank should be the only badge present. Centered on left pocket.
- Arrow of Light Award is worn centered below the right pocket.*
- Wear medals just above the pocket seam, and service stars centered just above medals or knots, or 3/8 inch above seam if no medals are worn.*
- Green background disks are worn with service stars for Boy Scouting.*
- Not more than five medals may be worn.*
- Embroidered Square Knots are worn centered over the left pocket flap in rows of three. A limited number of knotss are available to youth.*
- The World Crest is worn centered between the left shoulder seam and the top of the left pocket.*

5pts **Merit Badge Sash**

- Earned merit badges are attached to the front (and back, if needed).
- Temporary insignia may be worn on the back*
