



SUMMER CAMP PACKING CHECKLIST

IMPORTANT: This is a basic equipment checklist for general summer camp trips or other long-term camping events. This may be supplemented by additional information supplied by the venue or Troop Leaders based on activities, merit badges, locations, etc..

MEDICATION & FORMS

- Meds in original packaging w/ dosage information placed in plastic bag.
- Full Name & "TROOP 12" written on bag.

CLOTHING

- Class A Uniform (shirt, pants/shorts, neckerchief, etc.). To be worn during travel, meals and ceremonies.
- Class B Shirt or Scout-appropriate T-Shirt
- OA Sash (if applicable)
- Sweatshirt or Hoodie
- Light Jacket or Windbreakers
- 6 pairs Socks
- 6 pairs Underwear
- 6 T-Shirts
- 1 pair Jeans/Long Pants
- 3 pairs Shorts
- Belt
- Swimming Trunks
- Gym Shoes
- Hiking Boots
- Shower Shoes/Sandals
- Poncho/Raingear
- Hat

TOILETRIES

- Soap in Plastic Case
- Shampoo in Small Bottle
- Bathing Towel
- Swimming/Beach Towel
- Toothbrush & Toothpaste
- Comb
- Laundry Bag
- Deodorant
- Insect Repellent
- Sun Screen (SPF 15 or higher)

CAMPING GEAR

- Sleeping Bag
- Pillow
- Backpack/Daypack
- Mess Kit (Plate, Bowl, Cup)
- Vittle Kit (Fork, Knife, Spoon)
- Flashlight (w/ Extra Batteries)
- Reuseable Water Bottle
- Cot with Rounded-Bottom Legs
- Sleeping Pad/Mat

PERSONAL GEAR

- Scout Handbook
- Pens & Pencils
- Notepads/Notebooks
- Printed Merit Badge Worksheets
- Materials Needed for MB Requirements (if applicable)
- Money for Merit Badges (if applicable)
- Watch
- Pocketknife (and Totin' Chip)
- Spending Money
- Camp Chair/Stool

OPTIONAL GEAR

- Merit Badge Pamphlets
- Cheap Sunglasses
- Camera
- Camping Hammock
- Sporting Equipment (soccer ball, frisbee, etc.)
- Work Gloves
- Props for Approved Campfire Skits
